

Design Contest: Presenter Instructions

Before the conference:

Determine space requirements and request table. Deadline: July 21, 2019

Estimate how much space you require for your demo, and fill in the below poll to request 1) a full table (150cm x 75cm), or 2) half a table (75cm x 75cm). Please seriously consider half a table since we can hardly fit 21 full tables in our dedicated conference room (Hodler area in Rolex Learning Center), according to the local event organizers. Note that in addition to the table, you also get a 120cm wide x 180cm high poster wall.

Upload final 2-page demo description (PDF) and 1-2 teaser slides (PPTX). Deadline: July 24, 2019

Upload the final 2-page demo description (in PDF format) and a 1-2 teaser slides (as PPTX presentation) to the following Dropbox upload folder:

The 2-page demo description is the same document you already uploaded to SoftConf, but with the following naming convention:

Note that we will pull the final demo descriptions from the Dropbox upload folder (and not from SoftConf). A single PDF file containing all demo descriptions will be made available to the conference attendees as download in the conference app.

During the conference, we will have a 1-hour session to introduce the demos, right before the demo session. Each presenter will have a 2min slot to deliver a teaser for his/her demo, in order to attract people to his/her demo. Please prepare 1-2 slides in PPTX format, using the provided template (available as download from Dropbox, see link below). While you can have up to 2 slides, please remember that you will have only 2 minutes to present. This time limit will be enforced strictly to stay on schedule.

Use the following naming convention for the teaser PPTX:

We will combine all teasers into a single PPTX presentation before the conference.

Finalize demo and poster. Deadline: Before you travel, or before your shipping deadline

We provide a poster wall measuring 120cm wide x 180cm high for each demo. We recommend that you bring a poster in A0 format (portrait) to accompany your demo and highlight the main innovations which led to your low-power design.

We will provide a table (full or half, as requested in the poll), a poster wall, and power strips with roughly 5 outlets for your demo at the conference. We expect you to bring everything else, such as power supplies, lab equipment, monitors, demo boards, etc., on your own.

During the conference:

Monday, July 29, starting 10:00

We will have the event organizer open the room and place the tables before 10:00 on Monday, so that you have enough time to set up your demo starting at 10:00. Each table will have a label containing the submission number and the title of your demo – make sure to find and use your assigned table! The tables/demos are arranged and clustered according to topics.

Monday, July 29, 2019, 16:30 – 17:30: Design Contest Short Presentations

Please double-check the time and location of the Design Contest short presentations session in the program of the conference the morning of the first conference day. Please be present in the presentation room at least 20min before the start of the session and check in with the Design Contest Chair, Pascal Meinerzhagen. Your slides will be preloaded on the computer in the presentation room. The Design Contest Chair will let you know the sequence of the presentations ahead of time. Make sure that you sit in the front row and that you are ready to walk up to the stage when it is your turn to present.

Monday, July 29, 2019, 17:45 – 19:30: Demos

Demo session. Please make sure that one or several presenters are at the demo during the entire session. Amaze the audience with your low power design innovations!

Tuesday, July 30, 18:30 – open: Banquet and Awards

We will announce the winners of the Design Contest and hand out the prizes during the evening Banquet on Tuesday.
